Artist Statement

Since my childhood I have been inspired by the natural world. Our family home was surrounded by pristine bush. The nearby beach and river was an idyllic playground. My father was an expert fisherman, and it seemed we had an endless supply of food from the sea. My recent paintings are inspired by those times.

I paint with watercolour on paper or vellum, the traditional method used by natural history illustrators. My subjects are drawn from life, painstakingly measured and colour matched. The paintings can be viewed as still life studies. In some I have included plates and utensils separating them to some degree from strictly scientific illustrations. These elements give reference to moments shared at the family table and reinforce the idea of fish as food. My subjects were delicious!




